Easy Steps to Register Online for Lifelong Learning Classes

1) Go to the registration page

- Visit TheCenterDuxbury.org
- Click Register for a Lifelong Learning Program

2) Pick your class

- Click the class you want

3) Log in

- Enter your phone number

4) Register and check out
